Among the Share Options granted above, 999,000 Share Options^{Note 2} were granted to LI Chao Wang, Executive Director and Chairman of the Board in Tranche 1.

Note 1: Such benchmarks are identical to those set by the Board for Tranche 3 of Share Options granted on 2 May 2012.

Note 2: the amount of approximately 0.1% of the Company's outstanding share capital, is within the maximum number of options that can be granted by the Company to a substantial shareholder in a twelve-month period, pursuant to Rule 17.04 (1) under the Listing Rules.

Save as disclosed above, none of the Grantees is a Director, chief executive or substantial shareholder of the Company, or any of their respective associates (as defined in the Listing Rules).

Each Share Option shall entitle the holder of the Share Option to subscribe for one Share upon exercise of such Share Option at an exercise price of HK\$10.34 per Share, which represents the highest of (i) the closing price of HK\$9.98 per Share as stated in the daily quotation sheets issued by the Stock Exchange on 2 May 2013, being the Date of Grant; (ii) the average closing price of HK\$10.34 per Share as stated in the daily quotation sheets issued by the Stock Exchange for the five business days immediately preceding the Date of Grant; and (iii) the nominal value of the Share.

In the case of grants in favour of the Executive Director and Chairman, the grant of the Share Options was reviewed and recommended by the Remuneration Committee of the Company and was unanimously approved by all the Independent Non-Executive Directors on 2 May 2013. Whereas in all other cases, the Directors have unanimously approved the grants to employees.

The Board believes the grant of the Share Options to be an effective means to provide incentives to the Directors and employees of the Group to further the long-term interests of the Company and to align their interests with those of the shareholders of the Company.
